A minimum of 129 semester hours is required to graduate from Brenau University with a music education. After completing liberal education and major requirements, if the total number of hours on the student's transcript is not at 129 then the student must take enough general elective hours to reach a cumulative total of 129 hours. If a course is repeated, it is the student's responsibility to contact the Registrar's Office to adjust the earned hours on their transcript so that they are not short hours at graduation. Due to placement, a student may graduate with more than 129 ester hours.

Note: Financial aid recipients cannot receive aid for courses repeated unnecessarily or for courses not specifically required for their degree.
Note: No grade less than "C" may be applied in the major. Students must earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and a major grade point average of 2.75.

## Residency requirement:

A residency requirement of 33 semester hours is required to graduate from Brenau University with a music education major. This includes a major residency of 21 semester hours.
